TOURNAMENT DUTIES

SET UP

- Set up canopies — 1 in front of concession window, 1 in front of side window of building on BBQ side and 1 each at Ed Bryant/Resch for scorers. Canopies are stored in the storage (lower) room of the score booth.
- Place table with pitch count flip chart for scorekeepers at Ed Bryant
- Mount portable scoreboard and pitch count board on the poles beside the bleacher at Ed Bryant
- Make sure the score booth is open and scoreboard is turned on

TAKE DOWN (commence as soon as possible after the end of the last games of the day)

- Reverse of what is described for SET UP.

GROUND MAINTENANCE

- For the first game of the day, the infields should be ready 1/2 hour before game time.
- The team responsible for preparation of the infield includes raking/dragging, watering, and lining the base paths, and coaches' boxes. Have 4-5 people available to help.
- Use the 4-wheel marker for the base lines and the two-wheel marker for the boxes and warm-up circle. Open the 4-wheel marker only enough to allow chalk to flow through; push the liner as quickly as possible and MAKE ONLY ONE PASS. The base line does not have to be continuous; just evident enough for the umpire to be able to determine foul balls. Too much chalk makes it difficult for the umpire to clearly determine the base line.
- IMPORTANT: When possible water the infield with the hand held hose. If time does not permit a full infield water, water the area around and behind home plate and the base paths.

EMERGENCY GROUNDS CREW:

This team is responsible, in the event of evening rain, to go to the diamonds early (6:30am) to ensure they are dragged and are in suitable conditions for playing. Use Diamond Dry if required.

GARBAGE CREW:

This team is responsible for emptying the garbage during the day and replacing with fresh bags

SCOREKEEPING:

The **HOME team** (Team listed first on schedule) is responsible for scorekeeping and pitch counts.

HOST ZONE:

Responsible for updating scores to results board. Notifying teams via email of games to be played on Sunday.
